UPDATES FROM THE SCHOOL



Dear Eagle Families,

As parents and educators, it's often difficult to navigate monitoring our children's activities when it comes to their online activities, phone/texting use, and choice of media materials (books, games, etc.). Yet, stakes are high and certain statements and activities can have lasting impacts an a child and their family. It's vital that parents are partners with educators in daily monitoring of their children's online activities, phone activity, and reading materials. Some things to keep in mind:

 Our school's GoGuardian internet monitoring is is actively monitored by staff during school-day hours on days when students

are in attendance. This means that guardians must be actively monitoring their children's online activities while at home and beyond school-day hours.

Even activities that happen outside of school-day hours and off school grounds can result in
disciplinary action if such activity impact the operations of the school. This is especially true
in any instances of threats against students, staff, or school of any kind or engagement in
criminal activity using school devices.

Over the past few weeks, we've seen a significant increase in students using texting and group chats to engage in inappropriate, mean, threatening, and bullying behavior among our 4th - 8th grade students. All of these activities have happened outside of the school day using cell phones and other devices equipped with chat/text capability. We encourage guardians to speak with their student about appropriate and unacceptable topics of conversation, and what to do if they see anyone making threats, making fun of others, sending inappropriate pictures or images, referencing self harm, or encouraging others to not be friends with someone. Please actively monitor your student's phone, text, and chat activity. Let them know that you expect them to follow our school policy of depositing their phone in the appropriate box upon arrival at school. If you find out that your student has breached expectations, take swift action and implement consequences - including removal of phone/internet privileges and re-establishing expectations for appropriate behavior online and when texting/chatting with others.

When it comes to media exposure, there are many books and games that appear to be geared toward children, yet content is not appropriate for young people. One great resource is <u>Common Sense Media</u>, which provides unbiased information regarding books, movies, games, tv shows, podcasts, and apps. Our Librarian, Mrs. Williams, also wants guardians to be aware of a new literary genre called "New Adult," which is distinctly different from Young Adult. As always, we are here to help and support as part of your family's village in supporting our children in growing into empathetic, confident, and responsible lifelong learners who see themselves as contributors to their communities.

WHAT DOES THE BOARD DO?
